Thank you for being interested in working with Stan Stephens Glacier and Wildlife Cruises. We hope that the details included in this packet assist you with understanding our hiring needs, requirements, and processes. If you have additional questions, please feel free to contact us at any time.

Stan Stephens Cruises, Inc. (SSC) employs between 25 – 35 seasonal co-workers each year between the months of May – September. Our co-workers are crucial to the success of our business filling the roles of Deckhands and Reservation crew. Job descriptions for each position are attached.

Please note that when you apply, we are going to ask you specify the dates that you will be available to work as well as any requested time off. We do operate May – September, but we start and end our operations with reduced service. Therefore, if you are not available for the full season, please specify. Our co-workers have a variety of start and end dates.

We will accept applications on a year-round basis for seasonal jobs. Please submit applications as early in the year as you can, positions will be filled as qualified applicants are identified. Ideally, we can complete our hiring process for each summer by March.

As you apply, please make note of the following employment requirements:

- All safety sensitive employees are subject to pre-employment and random drug testing as required by the US Coast Guard. This testing process includes marijuana.
- Testing for COVID may take place during summer operations.
- Masking may be required for all employees while working in inside spaces depending on infection rates and client requirements.

Stan Stephens Cruises will provide all necessary training relative to safety, customer service, food handling, computer use and vessel operations. This training will take place virtually and in person.

Job Description :: Deckhand

The primary responsibility of a Deckhand (DH) is to assist the Master in ensuring the vessel and passengers are safe and that the customers have an unforgettable Alaskan experience. To do this a DH must excel in customer service and they must be able to understand the safety procedures on board. In addition, they must learn the history and geography of Prince William Sound. This is a seasonal position that is based on the individual employee's letter of agreement.

The Deckhand is considered a safety-sensitive position.

Job Duties (include but are not limited to):

- Learn, perform, and teach safe line handling techniques.
- Know and be able to perform and respond accordingly to all positions on the Station Bill.
- Know and be able to perform procedures for Person Overboard, Fire Aboard Ship, and Abandon Ship.
- Learn and be able to perform First Aid and CPR.
- Assist with the safe preparation and service of meals on board.
- Work in the coffee bar and sell gift shop items and refer to an inventory list when necessary.
- Gain and exhibit knowledge of local history, geology, industry, etc.
- Provide answers to and assist passengers.
- Learn and exhibit good customer service skills.
- Be alert to all that is going on around you; practice accident prevention.
- Be respectful and fair in your interactions; facilitate problem solving.
- Be flexible and prepared to react appropriately and promptly to incidents as they arise.
- Be familiar with Stan Stephens Cruises' policies and work by them.
- Strive to see that all our customers' expectations are exceeded.
- Participate in safety reviews.
- Be able to lift a minimum of 50 lbs.
- Be able to twist, kneel, crawl and climb, as the job requires.

Job Description :: Reservationist

A Reservationist at Stan Stephens Cruises is the first contact point our customers have with our company, whether it is in person, on the phone or via an email. Therefore, the primary responsibility of a person in this position is to help customers book a cruise in the Sound. This is a seasonal position that is based on the individual employee's letter of agreement.

Job Duties (include but are not limited to):

- Answering questions guests have on the phone, in an email or in person.
- Answering questions for traveler's journeys through Alaska and in particular Prince William Sound.
- Learning the reservation system and how to navigate about it.
- Developing an "expert" product knowledge of SSC products.
- Taking reservations.
- Assisting with the on-time departures of each vessel, including passenger check-in.
- Participating in staff meetings.
- Gaining a general knowledge of Valdez, Prince William Sound and Alaska.
- Be able to lift a minimum of 50 lbs.
- Be able to twist, kneel, crawl and climb, as the job requires.

- Be able to twist, kneel, crawl, and climb as the job requires.
